Consent Agenda

Approval of Minutes

Buffie made the motion to approve the November 21, 2023 version 5, Council meeting minutes. Teri seconded the motion. The Council members present approved the minutes.

Mobilizing Our Mission

2024 Budget Rev. David/Buffie

The 2024 budget was roughed out by Rev David, Marlisa and Buffie.

The pledge goal for 2024 was \$200,000 and the current level is \$180,000. At the previous meeting the total was listed as \$174,000 but that was due to not all pledges having been received yet.

Although the Center is currently about \$23,000 in the red, it is anticipated that at the end of 2024 the Center will be \$4,000 in the black. We are not making up the difference from 2023 but our operational costs are not expected to exceed income next year.??? but our operational costs are not expected to exceed income next year.

Rev. David cut his education budget in half for 2024, from \$2,000 to \$1,000.

Discussion that pledgers get quarterly updates for the status of their pledges.

Discussion on Staff raises. Only the Bookkeeper was given a raise due to this position having gone the longest without having a raise.

The Finance committee will go over the 2024 budget at their next meeting. Then the budget will be brought to the next Council meeting for review and approval.

Community Meeting topics/agenda

The January Community meeting was discussed during the last meeting. The question was raised, were there additional ideas that need to be discussed? The Visioning planned for the meeting, in additional to the regular reports will be enough for this community meeting.

Bring a Friend to Church planning

Angelina

Discussion on the "Bring a Friend to Church" day. Some people have difficulty in articulating what CSL is. It would be good to have a brochure for people to have to give others when they invite them to church. This may help people feel more comfortable in extending an invitation to others.

Last meeting the book "How to Speak Religious Science" was discussed. The book has been renamed to "How to Speak Science of Mind." Teri has ordered a few copies to circulate and made a suggestion to make a two-sided wallet card, that can be used to give people. We might have a laminated copy for ourselves.

Council discussed the CSL Seattle information that was emailed to the Council by Angelina. We have not yet asked for permission to use this text on our own promotional materials. We are still in the process of working out what we need.

Kathy mentioned that in talking to couples about inviting people to the Center, we may impact the youth program since couples may bring their children when they visit the Center. We should keep this in mind when we have our "Invite a Friend to Church" weeks.

It was mentioned that Adrienne has a Youth & Family brochure.

Discussion of creating the marketing avatar representing 30-40 year-old women that have young children and are searching for a spiritual community. Many women are now waiting until their 30's to have children. We need to be prepared for having additional youth and have additional volunteers.

Kathy will if some folding screens are available to provide some sectioning off for use by the different youth age groups. We have also discussed a portable building placed behind the Center to use for expanding the youth program capacity.

Marketing Team update

Angelina

Angelina would like to get started on the talking points brochure and asked if the Council was in agreement. Also, if anyone was interested in working on it, Angelina would like to invite other Council members to work with her on this.

Discussion of other places to look for inspiration for the brochure, Mile High CSL, Gregg Braden, etc.

Rev. David mentioned the following points:

- Information that is posted on the website
- We can discuss with others how SOM has changed their life
- There is also a book called "What Religious Science Teaches" by Ernest Holmes that breaks down things into four points which is easier than the list of thirteen things ("What We Believe".) We should buy some of these.
- Invite people to listen to a podcast or watch a YouTube service.

The marketing team will meet one more time, then not again until January. The Dec 26th meeting is cancelled.

Groundskeeper Position
