Approval of Minutes

Approval of Financials

Rev. David led the review of the June financial report.

Pledged income is 91% of the projected budget.

The investment account increased by a little over \$12,000 this month.

The Administrative assistant will go to a fixed rate instead of an hourly rate. The fixed rate will be the equivalent of 5 hrs./week pay. The contract will be adjusted to reflect this. Laura will send the contract to Rev David for revision.

Building Rental Event Needs

Tiffany

We are still learning about how to do building rentals. Kathy shared valuable information with us after the memorial service.

Tiffany shared a general list she created for the rental process. Tiffany should be the primary contact for renters. The list will be distributed to Council for input.

Other items mentioned:

We want to encourage people to pay deposit and rental fees online.

We need to have an administrative fee to pay for a paid staff member to be present at the event or have an Event Host service team of volunteers.

We will offer set-up/take down service for a fee (custodian), or the renter can have their own volunteers set up and take down to our satisfaction.

Purpose of Investments & Savings

Buffie

Buffie posed the question of the purpose of our savings and investment accounts. This will be discussed at a future Council meeting. Rev. David will speak with the donor who began our investment account for their views prior to any Council decision. It will be suggested for discussion on the first meeting of the month when we do not have financials to review.

An example of uses for this money are purchasing another dishwasher. Events using dishes really need to have a second dishwasher available to get the large number of dishes done without doing hand dish washing.

Delegates for 2024

Kick off could be Saturday September 30th or Sunday October 1st. After review of the calendar, it was decided that we would do a celebration party at the end.

We could do a soft launch and have a visioning for people to get a theme for the next year.

Council decided that November 12th will be a celebration of our success instead of having the Community meeting.

The visioning for the 2024 campaign theme with current members will be done on Sunday after service on Sunday September 24th.
